The pre-tax annual salary is about 20,000 RMB higher than that for the Peking University Boya Postdoctoral Fellowship. Other compensations and requirements are similar to Boya.

The application time is usually in January-February, and the result is presented in April.

Requirements: This is a full-time position. The applicants must have obtained a PhD degree within five years prior to the application date. The applicants may apply in any time.

Process: The applicants must first contact Professor Jintai Lin, with required information, for an initial (and usually the determining) screening. The applicants who have passed the initial screening may then submit their official application materials to the Peking University Postdoctoral Office before 15th of each month for additional check in order to start in the next month.

Compensation : The postdoc will receive a pre-tax annual income of 180,000 RMB, which includes salary (120,000 RMB) and housing subsidy (60,000 RMB). In addition, Peking University pays additional 64,000 RMB for health and retirement insurances.
